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DEBRIS BOX CONTAINER TERMS & CONDITIONS OF USE

Debris box containers provided by Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal (TTSD/ the Company) are to be used for their intended purpose only and container placement is not to be relocated without permission from TTSD. Proper care of company-provided debris box containers is the responsibility of the customer. Customer is responsible for all damages to debris box containers exceeding normal wear and tear.

Debris box containers must not be overloaded in excess of the "water level" full capacity of its dimensions. No additional equipment should be used to compact items placed within the container. No items can protrude beyond the dimensions of the container. Heavy items should be evenly distributed in the bottom of the box. Additional charges will apply if debris exceeds capacity in volume and/or weight. All containers must be legally transportable according to US DOT regulations. If a container is deemed to be grossly overweight and cannot be safely moved, excess material must be removed by the customer. If a container is determined to be overweight when scaled, additional overweight fees will apply.

Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal is not responsible for damage to customer property or surfaces incurred in the normal course of operations, including delivering, servicing and retrieving debris box containers. TTSD will not be held liable for any damage to asphalt, concrete, brick, wood or earthen driveways, pads, roadways or other surfaces where a debris box is placed or removed. Customer hereby agrees to terms and conditions of use and waives all claims for property damage or other loss, injury, death, or claim against, arising out of the delivery, removal, or use of said container. The customer similarly agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Company against all loss or liability from risks or claims arising from container location or placement. Customer is responsible for all damage to TTSD-provided containers due to overloading, misuse and/or neglect.

CUSTOMERS SECURING ORDERS AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING DEBRIS BOX CONTAINER TERMS & CONDITIONS / GUIDELINES

SCHEDULING, TIME LIMITS, AND RENTAL CHARGES

TTSD CANNOT GUARANTEE SERVICE TIMES. Debris boxes (bins, dumpsters) deliveries and removals are scheduled for weekdays, for term limits of 5 days plus delivery during the day before and removal during the day after. Drivers may arrive to deliver as late as 6pm and as early as 6am for removal. Periods shorter than 5 days may be available, subject to availability and advance scheduling by the customer. Longer periods must also be scheduled in advance by the customer, subject to availability and waste content as well as additional per day rental charges after the initial period. Daily rental charges vary, depending on season and availability. TTSD reserves the right to remove debris boxes if the rental exceeds one month. Applicable charges apply through the final service date.

All orders are on a first-come, first-serve basis. All deliveries must be prepaid. TTSD suggests orders be called in at least one business day in advance to assure better likelihood of delivery. Order earlier for weekends and holidays. Attempts for same-day orders must be made as early as possible. TTSD office is located at 645 West Lake Blvd, Suite 5, Tahoe City. Hours: 8am to 4:30pm M-F.

DEBRIS BOX PLACEMENT

Placement locations must be on a safe and level surface with no immediate overhead wires. Location must be clearly removed from public easements and county maintained roads. Persons ordering service must have the authority to place orders, including the property owner approval to use the designated site.

DAMAGES

Customers are responsible for damaged and/or overloaded debris boxes. Prior to service, a clear and safe path must be available for truck and debris box (e.g. NO vehicles, equipment, tools, or excess debris including snow and ice). Large debris box service requires the following minimum clearances: 18' height, 12' width, 80' maneuvering length. TTSD reserves right to refuse delivery if, in its discretion, placement location is unsafe or unsuitable. TTSD is not responsible for damage to surfaces on which the debris box is placed or over which the TTSD truck must travel. Customers who wish to protect surfaces must do so in advance on their own accord. Customers should not move debris boxes as the attempts to do so may result in damages to the box and/or the site surface.

SAFE TO HAUL

ALL DEBRIS BOXES MUST BE SAFE TO LEGALLY HAUL ACCORDING TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RULES AND REGULATIONS. DEBRIS BOXES MUST NOT BE OVERLOADED BY WEIGHT AND/OR VOLUME. DEBRIS IN ALL BOXES MUST NOT EXCEED THE DIMENSIONS OF THE BIN, INCLUDING THE TOP RIM OF THE BOX ("water-level" full only). NO DIRT OR ROCKS ALLOWED IN BINS. Other heavy items of special concern include sheetrock, composition, sod, bricks, tile, asphalt. Heavy materials must be evenly distributed in the bottom of the box. If a box is deemed unsafe to haul, it will not be serviced until excess material is removed by the customer. Overweight fees will be applied if bin is determined to be overweight when scaled.

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

All debris boxes are billed a haul fee plus disposal costs. Overweight bins are subject to additional charges and/or refusal of service until properly loaded by the customer.

- 6 Cubic Yard Debris Box: No heavy items (e.g. dirt, rocks, bricks, composition roofing). Limit 2,000 pounds (1 ton).
- 20 Cubic Yard Debris Box: Limit 8,000 pounds (4 tons).
- 30 Cubic Yard Debris Box: Limit 10,000 pounds (5 tons).
- 10 Cubic Yard "Rock Box": Limit 18,000 pounds (9 tons). Contents restricted to inert materials ONLY (e.g. concrete, dirt, brick, rock). Garbage or contamination of any kind is prohibited. Unauthorized materials are subject to load rejection and/or significant extra charges. Surface protection is recommended and is the customer's responsibility. Damage waivers must be signed prior to placement.

RESTRICTIONS TO TYPE OF DEBRIS

APPLIANCES: All large appliances should be placed in an accessible location on top of the load. Refrigerators, freezers, and/or air conditioners will be assessed an additional Freon removal charge per item; based on current ERL rates for Freon removal.

OTHER ITEMS: Limit of four tires (regular auto) per dumpster. Other questionable items (tanks, compromised soils, engines, etc) must be pre-approved by Placer County Health Department. Bins containing any of the above items will be returned full subject to extra charges, unless item has been approved and/or compensation has been made.

HAZARDOUS and/or toxic materials, bio-hazardous wastes, explosives, or gasoline tanks are prohibited in all debris boxes. TTSD is not a hazardous waste hauler. By law, we cannot accept autos or any hazardous wastes (e.g.. paint, insecticides, anti-freeze, medical waste, batteries, toxins, asbestos). Small quantity generators of household hazardous waste may self haul, subject to restrictions.

PROPER HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL: Electronics, automobile oil and batteries are accepted at the ERL MRF. Other hazardous wastes may be disposed at the ERL Household Hazardous Waste Facility, but require appointments. Call for more information.
